



#### COLOR

MODEL: Kara ARTIST: Mary Cuomo

### NATURAL LEVEL: 5

**CANVAS** LEVEL: 10 with previous color

### SECTIONING:

- Take a vertical section from the apex to the top of the right ear; clip this section away.
- 2. Repeat on the opposite side and leave the fringe to fall where it lives.
- 3. Using a Paul Mitchell<sup>®</sup> ProStix, twist up the back segment.
- Apply Wipe Out\* to the entire hairline and adhere a color visor to the front hairline.



## PRE-LIGHTENING:

- Using Dual-Purpose Lightener with 20 volume Paul Mitchell\* Cream Developer, lift the natural base to a level 9 or 10. Utilize fine 1/8" sections and small foils to ensure even lift on and off the scalp.
- Rinse well and mix a Color Balance formula (Dual-Purpose Lightener + 10 volume Paul Mitchell<sup>®</sup> Cream Developer + Shampoo One<sup>®</sup>). Emulsify the Color Balance mixture through the ends to remove previous color stains.
- 3. Rinse and shampoo with Color Protect<sup>®</sup> Post Color Shampoo. Condition with MarulaOil Rare Oil Replenishing Conditioner.

## POP XG:

- Emerald: 2 oz. POP XG<sup>®</sup> Teal + 2 oz.
  POP XG<sup>®</sup> Green + ½ oz. POP XG<sup>®</sup> Midnight
- Kelly Green: 2 oz. POP XG<sup>®</sup> Teal + 2 oz. POP XG<sup>®</sup> Green
- Yellow: 2 oz. POP XG<sup>®</sup> Yellow

- Starting in the fringe area, apply the emerald formula at the base and the kelly green through the ends. Blend the line where these two meet.
- 2. Moving to the back segment, start with a ½" horizontal section in the nape area and paint the **emerald** formula at the base and feather the **yellow** formula up into the base color, keeping the yellow in the middle 1/3 of the strand. Once the base and mid-lengths are colored, paint the **kelly green** through the ends. Repeat this pattern for the first 2 horizontal sections in the back.
- 3. Take down the next section and continue to apply the **emerald** at the base, painting 1/3 of the way down the strands. Transition now into the **kelly green** formula in the mid-lengths and the **yellow** through the ends.
- ✓ Tip: Separate each section with clear film and be sure to paint underneath the sections as well for clean, thorough saturation.

- 4. Complete 2 sections with this pattern and return back to the original pattern from Step 2. Continue up to the top of the back segment, alternating every 2 sections.
- ✓ Tip: On some of the longer-length sections, alternate colors through the ends several times, but always maintain the **emeraid** at the base. As you approach the top of the back segment, return to the 3 color patterns from the previous steps.
- Move to the front side sections and take vertical sections. Paint using the same patterns from the back, keeping the emerald at the base and alternating the kelly green and yellow through the ends.
- ✓ Tip: Only paint the **emeraid** base color 1" down the hair strands and separate the sections with plastic film.
- Process for 30 minutes and rinse. Shampoo with Color Protect\* Post Color Shampoo and condition with the Paul Mitchell\* conditioner of your choice.
