MODEL: Tonia

CANVAS LEVEL: 10

SECTIONING:

1. Using the haircut's weight line as a starting point, section out the entire underneath. Clip everything up and out of the way, leaving the short back weight line, sides and front area free to paint.

POP XG:

- **Opalescent:** 1 oz. **POP XG**® Opalescent
 - **Sterling blue:** 1 oz. **POP XG**® Silver + pea-size **POP XG**® Midnight
 - **Tangerine:** 1 oz. **POP XG**® Diluter + ¼ oz. **POP XG**® Orange + ¼ oz. **POP XG**® yellow + ¼ oz. **POP XG**® Pink + pea-size **POP XG**® Red
1. Using a taper comb to apply, paint the **opalescent** formula to the entire underneath segment. Spread, coat and comb the paint using the taper comb.
 2. Take the **sterling blue** formula and, using a different taper comb, paint a shadowed design line on the entire weight line. Alternate long, solid strokes with smaller, crosshatched lines in between. Cover with clear plastic.
 3. Release the top segment and comb down to the natural fall. Choose 3 smaller sections on the top to clip away and paint the remaining hair with the **opalescent** formula.
 4. Working around the head shape, paint the 3 small sections with the **tangerine** formula, keeping sections separate with clear film. Use a sponge to "bounce" the **tangerine** formula on these sections.
 5. Process for 30 minutes and rinse. Shampoo with Color Protect® Post Color Shampoo and condition with Forever Blonde® Conditioner.
